

SUN Insurance Company moved from its first 360square-foot location to a building across the street. The current location, which is 10,000 square feet, opened in 2006.

Max Zoretic has since retired but continues to help guide the second Zoretic generation, Marcia and Daniel, who became co-principals of the agency in 1998. Both have backgrounds in the financial service industry and started their careers at a large corporate bank before transitioning to insurance.
